RESPONSE TO MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO OPPOSE PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Defendants

Defendants, members of the Alaska Judicial Council ("Council"), have moved for an order from the Court granting an extension of time to reply to Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction filed on July 2, 2009. Given the importance of this challenge to the Alaska State Constitution, Docket 22 at 2, and the compression of time caused by the July 4 holiday weekend, Plaintiffs agree to an additional two weeks for Defendants to prepare a response. Accordingly, Plaintiffs do not object to a new due date of July 31, 2009, for Defendants' response to Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction.

Nevertheless, expedition is still necessary in this case, given the gravity of the violation of Plaintiffs' rights under the Equal Protection Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment of the United States Constitution caused by the method for selecting the Attorney Members of the Alaska Judicial Council. The harm from this violation will become irreparable with respect to the current impending vacancy on the Alaska Supreme Court if Plaintiffs do not obtain the relief sought in their Motion for Preliminary Injunction before the Council begins the nomination process. The meeting at which the Council will consider and make nominations has now been set for October 15-18, 2009. Docket 22 at 3. Defendants will receive the compiled applicant materials approximately three weeks prior to the Council's meeting. Alaska Judicial Council, Procedures for Nominating Judicial Candidates IV (2007), available at http://www.ajc.state.ak.us/selection/Procedures/SelectionProcedures7-24-07.pdf. It is likely that the Council members will begin deliberations when they receive these packages, which would cause harm to Plaintiffs.

Due to the scheduling of the Council meeting and the potential deliberation by the Council members, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court set the consolidated hearing on their Motion for Preliminary Injunction and on the merits of this case, which was requested in Plaintiffs' Motion

for Consolidation, Docket 5, for a date in August 2009. The briefing extension requested by Defendants, Docket 22, together with a hearing in August, will permit the issues to be fully briefed and give adequate time for Plaintiffs to obtain the relief they require before the Council members receive the application packages and begin deliberations three weeks before the meeting of October 15-18, 2009.

Plaintiffs' counsel are available on the following dates for a hearing:

- The week of August 17-21, 2009
- The week of August 31 through September 4
- September 11, 14, and 15, 2009
- The week of September 28 through October 2

Finally, Plaintiffs do not require more time than the local rules provide to file their reply. D.Ak. LR 7.1(e). With a July 31, 2009, deadline for Defendants' response, Plaintiffs' reply will be due August 5, 2009.
